### **Burscough Dynamos**

A community based club, providing football opportunities for children and young people. They raise funds through monthly subscriptions and occasional fundraising events. The grant of £2400 was awarded for the refurbishment of the community room and pavilion including new flooring, lighting and heating. The room and pavilion are now available for hire within the local community as well as by its members.

#### Provision of a new bus shelter

A new bus shelter was commissioned by the Parish Council. The shelter was supplied and installed by B&C Shelter Solutions Limited on **Liverpool Road South, Burscough, L40 7RS**. The work was carried out in April 2017.

#### GrantScape (white moss): New picnic/play areas

It was decided that land adjacent to the canal and owned by Burscough Cricket Club would be converted into a new picnic and play area. This picnic and play area is public, for use by Burscough residents and the wider community. **The Parish Council was asked to contribute £2107** to complement the award of £18865 already secured by the cricket club from GrantScape. The work was completed in the middle of 2018.

## Mere Avenue: replacement playground equipment, safety surfacing and fencing

At the Parish Council meeting of 12/07/2017, it was agreed that expenditure be committed for the Mere Avenue play area. Yates Playgrounds Ltd were contracted to deliver the project, which would be met from a combination of precept, S106, a WLBC capital grant, CIL (£3000) and general reserves.
