Upgrading of existing infrastructure by refurbishing redundant telephone kiosks to house life saving defibrillators. Increased population because of new housing developments in Burscough has put extreme pressure on all health care facilities especially the Drs surgeries & ambulance services. This initiative could save lives by making an emergency response immediately available

Purchase of new playground equipment to enhance the local area for existing & new residents health & well being (50/50 CiL & S106 funding)

Upgrading of existing infrastructure. The clock Tower in Burscough has been refurbished to enhance the public realm for the benefit & enjoyment of new & existing residents of Burscough, and by providing insight into Burscough's history & heritage.

How it supports new development

Upgrading of existing infrastructure. The Station Interchange Building on the Southport/Manchester railway line which has been closed for 6 years has been leased & refurbished by Burscough Town Council for use as an office for Burscough Town Council staff and primarily for use by the increasing population of Burscough because of the new housing developments. There is a chronic shortage of public meeting space in Burscough for resident's groups, sporting groups, charities, social events etc. and the use of this building will provide a very valuable public asset for the community.
